What is a C.S.A.?

Community-supported agriculture is a way for the food buying public to create a relationship with a farm and to receive a weekly basket of produce. It is a relatively new way of food production, sales, and distribution aimed at both increasing the quality of food and the quality of care given the land – while substantially reducing potential food losses and financial risks for the farmer. By making a financial commitment to a farm, people become "members" of the CSA. The commitment in advance supports the costs of running the CSA, including seeds, fertilizer, labor, equipment and insurances. Our 2010 shares include a Main Season, and an optional winter share and flower share.

How Does our C.S.A. work?

At the farm, a box of produce (approx. 7 lbs) will be packed for each of our members. The box will be delivered every week to their designated pickup location. Either at our farm on Saturday, 12-4 or at Boston City Hall Plaza Farmers Market on Monday, 12-4.

The Main Season Share is a 15-week share. The share begins the week of July 12th and ends the week of October 18th. Cost is \$450. Produce will include, various fruit, vegetables, honey. Check out our website for more details on what to expect: www.keownorchards.com
